
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Project: Pillowcase with Precut Strips



FABRICS are from the Gypsy Caravan collection by Amy Butler for Rowan Fabric (westminsterfabrics.com).

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Materials

For one pillowcase:

 26—2½×44/45" precut strips or 2¼ yards total assorted prints (pillowcase body, band)

Finished pillowcase: 30×20" (fits a standard-size bed pillow)

Quantities are for 44/45"-wide, 100% cotton fabrics. Measurements include 1/4" seam

Cut Fabrics

allowances.

From 2½×44/45"- wide strips, cut:

- 6-2**1/2**×40**1/2**" strips
- 20-21/2×241/2" strips

Assemble Band

- 1. Referring to Diagram 1, sew together long edges of six assorted print 2½×40½" strips. Press seams in one direction. Topstitch through all layers ½" from each seam, holding seam allowances in place.
- 2. Join short ends of Step 1 unit to make a loop. Press seam open. Fold loop in half with wrong side inside; press to make pillowcase band.

Assemble Pillowcase

1. Referring to Diagram 2, sew together long edges of 20 assorted print 2½×24½" strips to make a pieced rectangle.

The pieced rectangle should be 24½×40½" including seam allowances. Press seams in one direction. Topstitch through all layers ⅙" from each seam, holding seam allowances in place.

- 2. Fold pieced rectangle in half crosswise to form a 24½×20¼" rectangle. Sew together long edges and one pair of short edges to make pillowcase body. Turn right side out and press flat.
- Referring to Diagram 3, slide pillowcase band over pillowcase body; align raw edges and pin. Sew together through all layers.
- 4. Press pillowcase band open, pressing seam allowances toward pillowcase body. Topstitch 1/8" from band edge on pillowcase body to secure the



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
