



FABRICS are from the Into the Woods II collection by Kanvas Studio for Benartex (benartex.com).



#### Materials

- ½ yard total assorted prints (pillowcase band)
- ½ yard teal print (pillowcase band)
- ¼ yard leaf print (pillowcase band)
- 7/8 yard nature print (pillowcase body)
- Template plastic

Finished pillowcase: 30×20" (fits a standard-size bed pillow)

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances for piecing blocks and ½" seam allowance for pillowcase constructions. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

- $2\frac{1}{2}\times3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles. Press seams away from center square.
- 3. Add teal print 2½×7½"
  rectangles to remaining edges.
  Press seams away from
  center square to make a unit
  (Diagram 2). Repeat to make
  eight units total.
- 4. Place template atop a unit, aligning template center window with unit center square (Diagram 3). Mark outer template edges. Cut on marked lines to make a 5 ½" square block. Repeat to make four blocks total.
- Turn template over and repeat with remaining units to make four reversed blocks total (Diagram 3).

- Matching raw edges and seams, slide pillowcase band over pillowcase body with pieced side of band facing pillowcase body (Diagram 4); pin. Using a 1/4" seam allowance, sew together through all layers.
- 3. Press pillowcase band open, pressing seam toward pillowcase body. Topstitch 1/8" from band edge (Diagram 5) to secure seam allowance and complete pillowcase.

#### **Cut Fabrics**

From assorted prints, cut:

■ 8-3½" squares

From teal print, cut:

- 16-21/2×71/2" rectangles
- 16-2½×3½" rectangles

From leaf print, cut:

 $-1-5\frac{1}{2}\times40\frac{1}{2}$ " strip

From nature print, cut:

■ 1—25**¾**×41" rectangle

### Assemble Blocks

The pattern for cutting is on page 4. To make a template of the pattern, top it with template plastic and trace. Cut out the template on outer edges, then cut away the center square.

- 1. Gather one assorted print 3½" square, two teal print 2½×3½" rectangles, and two teal print 2½×7½" rectangles.
- 2. Referring to **Diagram 1**, join the print square and two teal print


#### Assemble Band


- 1. Alternate blocks and reversed blocks in a row. Sew together to make a 5½×40½" pieced strip (Band Assembly Diagram).
- 2. Sew together the pieced strip and leaf print 5½×40½" strip.
- Join short ends of Step 2 unit to make a loop. Press seam open. Fold loop in half with wrong side inside; press to make pillowcase band.


### Assemble Pillowcase

1. Fold nature print 25 \(^3\)4×41"
rectangle in half to form a
25 \(^3\)4×20 \(^1\)2" rectangle. Using
a \(^1\)2" seam allowance, sew
together long edges and one
set of short edges to make the
pillowcase body. Turn right side
out and press flat.












BAND ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM
